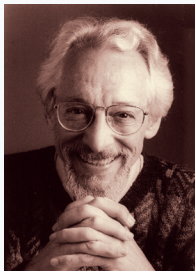

**ROBERT OSSERMAN** is Special Projects Director at MSRI and Professor Emeritus at Stanford.
